Candidate Requirements

• A valid driving licence for the class of vehicle if the training is required on the public highway.

Course Details

A certificated one-day course for a maximum of four operators, on a maximum of four topics specific to your equipment. This is conducted at your own premises, using your own vehicle. This allows us to train your operatives on their particular machine. CAST training can be adapted to bespoke customer requirements. Examples of topics requested include:

- Essential health and safety information.
- Overview and familiarisation of equipment.
- Essential daily and weekly checks.
- Suction nozzles how to correctly adjust for optimum performance.
- Sweeping brushes how to change, adjust and set position.
- Compact sweeper driving techniques kerb climbing, use of 4-wheel steer function.
- How to mount and demount snowploughs.
- Route Replay automated spreading introduction to operation and route selection.
- Winterization and cold weather procedures, use of onboard purge functions where fitted, including Pressadrain.
